






ADMISSION REOUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold at least a Bachelor's degree in any relevant field. Required documents for applying to the program include:

- A completed application form and two references
- Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL ≥ 500, IELTS ≥ 5.5 or its equivalent)
- Transcripts of undergraduate or graduate course work
- · A pre-proposal for a Master's thesis
- · Identification of a data set to use in the thesis (recommended)

All documents must be submitted by May. (Only application form may be submitted through e-mail). The final selection of qualified applicants will be announced by June. The first semester starts in August.
